When I visit Brean Play there are lots of things to:



OUTSIDE BREAN PLAY:



I MIGHT SEE:

- Cars or lorries driving past
- A big building with waterslides coming out of it which is called Brean Splash Waterpark
- The rides at Brean Theme Park
- Seagulls flying around
- Lots of people walking about
- Cars in the car park



OUTSIDE BREAN PLAY:




I MIGHT HEAR:

- Cars and lorries going past on the road
- Seagulls making a noise
- The wind blowing
- People or children talking, shouting or laughing
- Noises from the rides at the Theme Park



I MIGHT TOUCH:

- Concrete
- Glass
- Bricks
- Tarmac
- The wind, sun or rain



OUTSIDE BREAN PLAY:



I MIGHT SMELL:

- Fumes from the cars or lorries driving past
- Food cooking in the nearby restaurants

INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN PLAY:

- I or the person with me buys a ticket from Reception
- A lot of people like to visit Brean Play so sometimes there might be a queue and I might need to wait
- If I need anything or I am unable to queue, whoever is with me can make a team member aware of my needs



INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN PLAY:



I MIGHT SEE:

- A reception counter with gates that open and close
- Lots of signs with words and pictures on
- Tables and chairs



I MIGHT HEAR:


- People talking
- Music playing from the sound system
- The sound of a coffee machine making drinks
- The phone ringing

INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN PLAY:



I MIGHT TOUCH:

- Carpet
- Hard surface flooring
- Other people brushing past me



I MIGHT SMELL:

- Food or drink from the Brean Play Cafe



INSIDE THE ENTRANCE TO BREAN PLAY:

- The person with me will sign in and will be given a receipt
- The receptionist will open the gate
- I can choose where I sit. There are tables, chairs and soft sofa chairs
- I must remove any sharp items on my clothes and empty my pockets
- I must then take off my shoes and keep my socks on. I can use a locker if I wish



INSIDE BREAN PLAY:



I MIGHT SEE:

- The bright coloured play equipment in the two play areas. The toddler area is for under 4's and the main play area for ages 4 - 11.
- Sensory floor stickers to play on
- Children playing on the equipment or riding down the slides
- Team members in uniform
- Food and drink coming from the cafe



INSIDE BREAN PLAY:



I MIGHT HEAR:

- Music from the sound system
- A man or lady talking on the tannoy
- People talking, shouting, shrieking or laughing
- The fire alarm, which sounds like a siren. If this happens, the person with me will tell me what to do



I MIGHT TOUCH:

- The play equipment some of it may be soft and some of it may be hard
- People pushing past me or standing next to me



INSIDE BREAN PLAY:

👉 I MIGHT TASTE:

- Drinks or food from the Brean Play Cafe



👉 I MIGHT SMELL:

- Food from the Cafe



INSIDE BREAN PLAY THERE ARE LOTS OF THINGS I CAN DO:

- I can go around the play area in any direction I want
- I can go down the slides
- I can go on the slides
 - In any order I want to
 - Lots of times if I want to
 - Not at all if I don't want to
- There are lots of steps up to the slides
- Sometimes lots of people might want to go in the same area as me and I might have to wait
- I can go on the trampoline, 1 person at a time
- I can try things I may not have done before. A grown up must supervise me



INSIDE BREAN PLAY THERE ARE LOTS OF THINGS I CAN DO:

- I have to be under 4 to go in the toddler area
- I can come out of the play area any time I want to
- Brean Play can be noisy so I can wear ear defenders if I want to
- If I need a quiet space, I can ask the manager for access to the quiet room (usually available Mon - Fri)
- If I want to leave and I have only been in the play for a short time (less than 20 minutes), I can come back for my next visit free if the person I am with speaks to the Duty Manager to let them know before we leave



THE STEPS I MIGHT GO THROUGH WHEN I VISIT BREAN PLAY ARE:

1

I arrive at Brean Play

2

Inside, I or the person who is with me buys a ticket at Reception and the person with me signs in

3

The receptionist will open the gate

4

I remove any sharp items of clothing, empty my pockets and take off my shoes, leaving my socks on

5

I go in the play area for my age group

6

I get out of the play area and go to the toilet when I need to

7

I have some food and drink when I am hungry or thirsty

8

When I have finished in the Brean Play Area I will put my shoes on

9

It's time for me to leave and the person at Reception will check our receipt before opening the gate
